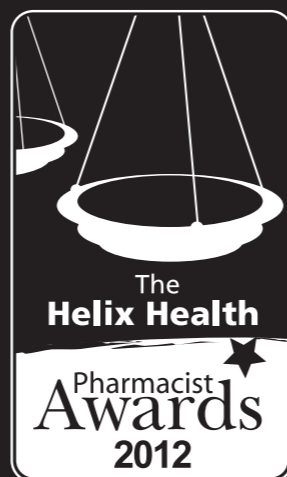

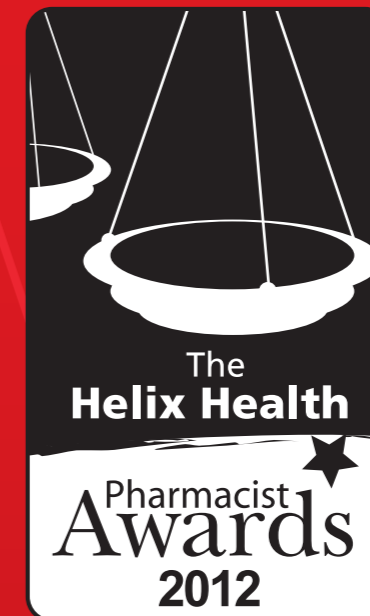

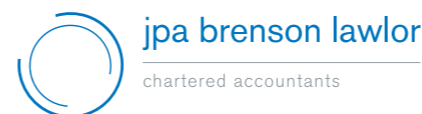

Helix Health Pharmacist Awards 2012

The aim of the Pharmacist Awards is to provide an occasion that recognises the contribution of the profession to healthcare in general, as well as to celebrate and reward pharmacists and their teams. Awards will be made to pharmacists who have displayed an exceptional and constructive interest in pharmacy and have thereby contributed significantly to the standing of the profession. Candidates may have distinguished themselves in the practice, science, research or profession of pharmacy. The awards are open to all pharmacists registered in Ireland, including hospital, industrial, academic and community pharmacists. Those who have rendered outstanding service to the profession will be eligible, as will qualified pharmacists who have made an exceptional contribution to the wider community outside the profession.



An adjudicating panel, which includes respected pharmacists from the various branches of the profession, will select three finalists and a winner in categories 1 to 7:

1 Helix Health Professional Excellence Award

This award is open to all pharmacists working in areas other than community or hospital pharmacy. This includes pharmacists working in industry, regulatory bodies, the HSE, administration and other roles.

Winner 2011: Julie O'Neill, Gileads Science Ltd., Co. Cork

2 The Pinewood Healthcare Pharmacist Contribution to the Community Award

To be awarded to a pharmacist working in any area of the profession who has, through involvement in non-pharmacy work, delivered notable benefits for the wider community.

Winner 2011: Padraic Staunton, Staunton's Pharmacy, Athboy, Co. Meath

3 The Actavis Excellence in Community Practice Award

To be awarded to a pharmacist whose exceptional professional efforts have enabled community pharmacy services to be delivered in a manner more beneficial to the public.

Winner 2011: Dermot Twomey, Cloynes Pharmacy, The Square, Cloyne, Co. Cork

4 The Teva Patient Nominated Award

To be nominated by patients and the members of the public. They will be asked to specifically detail why the professional conduct of this pharmacist was remarkable and noteworthy.

Winner 2011: Emmet McHugh, Eakins Pharmacy, Carrickmacross, Co. Monaghan

5 Excellence in Hospital Pharmacy Award

To be awarded to a hospital-based pharmacist who has delivered a new approach that enables pharmacy to be delivered in a manner more beneficial to the patient.

Winner 2011: Elaine Conyard, Our Lady of Lourdes, Dundalk, Co. Louth

6 The Lundbeck Practice-Based Research Award

This award is offered to identify, recognise and promote evidence-based strategies for optimising the delivery of pharmacy services. The Practice-Based Research Award entries should demonstrate how research has had a measurable impact in terms of improving patient care. Pharmacy Practice-Academic Collaborations will be viewed favourably by the judges.

7 Young Pharmacist of the Year Award

To be awarded to a pharmacist under the age of 30 years whose activities, in the course of their professional duties and development, is judged to be the most commendable.

8 The JPA Brenson Lawlor Liz Herbert Memorial Lifetime Achievement Award

To be awarded to the pharmacist, practising or recently retired, whose efforts on behalf of the profession in Ireland over a sustained number of years, are adjudged to have been the most remarkable.

9 Overall Pharmacist of the Year Award
